Please follow registration procedures listed in the back of the catalog. Trip registration is through the Recreation and Community Services Department at Lakewood City Hall. **All trips depart from the Burns Community Center, 5510 Clark Ave. in Lakewood unless otherwise noted.** Participant parking is available in the southeast parking lot of Burns. All destinations are wheelchair accessible unless indicated otherwise. **Please notify us when registering if you use a wheelchair or other mobility aid.** Departure and return times may be adjusted due to certain circumstances beyond our control. Please register early as seating is on a first come, first served basis. Registration is non-transferable. TRAVEL REFUNDS

Refunds will be granted only if the city is notified, the trip is full, and the space can be resold by the City of Lakewood prior to the day of the trip. All three of these conditions must be met to authorize a refund. There is also a \$5 administrative fee per person.

Mission Inn Festival of Lights

The Mission Inn's annual Festival of Lights is a spectacle you don't want to miss. We'll have an exclusive private 75-minute tour of the Inn, then you will have plenty of time to enjoy the holiday festivities on your own. The offerings include more than 4 million dazzling holiday lights, appearances by Santa Claus, the world's largest manmade mistletoe, horse-drawn carriage rides, freshly fallen snow, an elaborately decorated Christmas tree and delicious food or confections at local eateries. The City of Riverside has adopted a citywide initiative with a vision of a Dickensian holiday featuring lights and decorations throughout downtown Riverside featuring an outdoor ice-skating rink on the Main Street pedestrian mall, holiday vendors and family-friendly entertainment. Registration fee includes private tour and transportation. Dining and entertainment is on your own. Please arrive at 1:30 p.m. for check-in. The bus will leave promptly at 2:00 p.m. An adult must accompany children of all ages.

Petersen Automotive Museum

Join us for a private docent-led tour and learn how the Petersen Automotive Museum explores the history of the automobile. The museum's galleries tell thousands of stories highlighting more than three hundred vehicles, including the Back to the Future DeLorean "Time Machine," Steve McQueen's 1956 Jaguar XKSS and hundreds of rare and iconic vehicles spanning more than 120 years of automotive history. We'll get an overview of all three floors that will highlight some of the most interesting cars and exhibits. You'll have time to explore more on your own after the tour. Large or over-sized backpacks, camera bags, purses, diaper bags, umbrellas, and other similar items must be stored at the Security Office. Small bags for carrying necessary items are available for use. The museum may refuse to accept other items at its discretion and is not responsible for items held. Food and beverage are not permitted in the museum galleries, with the exception of water bottles that can be sealed with a lid.
